Request Limits

The limits are currently set to:

1. CREATES to 100reqs/1min
2. UPDATES to 1req/1min
3. GET to 3req/60min
4. DELETE to 3req/60min

These limits are applied at the complete URL of the endpoint. Ex:

- There will be an ErrorCode when the response status is anything other than the above

Required Fields

- BadgeNumber (*must be unique* - you can use your personId or regId for this if you like)
- RegistrationCode
 - Example: REG,1,<comma-separated-CTI-SessionIds>

- LastName
- FirstName
- EmailAddress

Rules/Considerations

- LastName, FirstName and EmailAddress as a combination must be unique, or else we assume it is a different person.
- If you want a blank string, pass "" but if you just don't want or need to send a field, you can remove it or send it with *null*.
